



“Upskirting” is the act of taking a photograph up a person’s skirt without their consent.

It is now a criminal offence in the UK, punishable with up to two years in prison and inclusion on the Sex Offenders Register.

Please ensure that your children are aware of this.

As a Club we fully advise **against** having any form of photographic equipment / phones in the changing rooms, however we do recognise that we live in a very technological world and most people like to have a phone with them at all times.

With this in mind, we will have a secure storage facility at the top end of the pool spectator area for your child to leave their phone at the start of any training session (if they wish to). Any phones left will need to be clearly marked with the owners name so that we can ensure we hand back the correct phone to the correct person.

We are not enforcing this policy but do strongly recommend that **NO PHONES** are taken into the changing rooms. If your child wishes to keep a phone with them then please note it is at the responsibility of the parent or guardian of that child and the Club accepts no liability or responsibility for any images taken.

We act to safeguard all Club members and will act immediately if we receive any reports of misuse.
